How does the SFAC team differ from other community agencies?

The SFAC, Located at BLD 220, 1778 3rd Street focuses primarily on assisting the warrior in Transition and his/ her Family Member during their transition. We are a one stop shop. We provide all the services tailored to the WT Soldier. We do the leg work, not you. All components of the Armed Forces are authorized SFAC support.
