SUBJECT: Command Policy Memorandum G3-01 – Priority for Scheduling Close-in Training Areas

1. Purpose: To publish guidance for priorities of use of close-in training areas and land within Major Subordinate Command (MSC) cantonment areas.

2. Priority of use of local training lands are identified into two categories, close-in training areas and cantonment areas:

a. Close-in training areas (Enclosures 1-3) are assigned to MSCs for priority of use. These areas are outside of the traditional rotational footprint, but still must be scheduled during the Resource Allocation Conference (RAC):

4/10th BCT	Castor 1 and 2 (VQ 790400) and the area within VQ 793401 to VQ 820400 to VQ 809377 to VQ 802372 to VQ 790377 to VQ 782381
1st MEB, 115th CSH, and NCOA	Rosepine 1, 2, and 3 (VQ 820315)
1-509th PIR	TA-4 (VQ 820410)
46th Engineer Battalion	Authorized dig site within the Tactical Driving Facility (VQ 815377)

b. Cantonment areas are located within the MSCs footprint. The MSCs are responsible for proper care and maintenance of these areas. Cantonment areas are assigned as follows:

4/10th BCT	Land north of Louisiana Ave from VQ 793401 to VQ 782381 to VQ 802373 to VQ803355 to VQ 811358 to VQ 815405
1st MEB, 115th CSH, and NCOA	Land south of Louisiana Ave from VQ 798341 to VQ 810337 to VQ 797328 to VQ 809328

1-509th PIR

Land south of Louisiana from VQ 800345 to VQ 803345 to VQ 798341 to VQ 803341

3. Vehicle training along utility right of ways (ROW) and pond levees is prohibited due to potential for damage to these structures.
4. These close-in training areas provide unique opportunities for Soldiers and I expect leaders to maximize the use of these resources.
5. This policy remains in effect until superseded or rescinded.
