SUBJECT: Garrison Policy Memorandum #10 - Alcohol Consumption at Home of
Heroes Soldiers Recreation Center

1. References.

a. Army Regulation 215-1, Military Morale, Welfare, and Recreation Programs and Nonappropriated Fund Instrumentalities, 24 September 2010.

b. Joint Readiness Training Center (JRTC) and Fort Polk Regulation 210-1, Alcoholic Beverages, 13 January 1998.

2. Soldiers who are not in a duty status, and are of the legal age of 21 years or older, may consume malt beverages and wine in the Home of Heroes Soldiers Recreation Center, Monday – Friday beginning at 1630, and on weekends.

a. At no time is anyone under the legal drinking age to consume alcoholic beverages.

b. Soldiers will not purchase or provide alcoholic beverages to persons under the age of 21.

3. Proponent. The Directorate of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation, Community Recreation Division is the proponent for this policy.

4. This policy will remain in effect until superseded or rescinded.
