RCI / PICERNE FACTS --- 50 YEAR PARTNERSHIP

- ◆ Since 2004, Fort Polk has partnered with RCI / Picerne to provide quality family housing.
- ◆ There are currently 2,685 homes with an end state of 3,853.
- ◆ The on-going improvements effort has resulted in 384 newly constructed homes, 2,560 renovations, and 292 demolitions.
- ◆ From September 2004 to January 2011, \$178.9M has been invested in family housing.

LODGING

- ◆ Fort Polk Privatized on-post lodging in 2009. The Army partner is Intercontinental Hotel Groups (IHG).
- ◆ IHG recently renovated and is now operated as a Holiday Inn. There are 70 rooms at the Holiday Inn with special rates for PCSing Families, and another 59 rooms at Cypress Inn located about 1 mile from the Holiday Inn.
- ◆ IHG offers free breakfast, a weekly barbeque, a free shuttle bus, and a snack area located in the lobby.
- ◆ IHG also managed the Distinguished Visitor Quarters with 18 rooms available for E6 and above. The reservations for the DVQs are coordinated with the Protocol Office.



TEMPORARY HOUSING

- ◆ To reduce out-of-pocket expenses, incoming Families may use 2-bedroom homes while they wait for on-post housing.
- ◆ Homes are located on post and managed by Intercontinental Hotel Groups (IHG).

FAMILY - FRIENDLY NEIGHBORHOOD CENTERS

Enhancing the quality of life for Military Families living on post is not just about homes, it is about neighborhoods. Our Neighborhood Centers are the core of each neighborhood.

- ◆ **Palmetto Neighborhood Center** was opened in September 2007



- ◆ **Maple Terrace Neighborhood Center** opened on May 19, 2009



- ◆ **Dogwood Terrace Neighborhood Center** opened on March 10, 2010.

- ◆ **Camellia Terrace Neighborhood Center** is slated to open summer 2011.

These facilities provide easy access to management and maintenance staff, meeting areas, gathering spaces, fitness centers, pools, media rooms, and computer labs for our residents. Perfect for the whole family.



SENIOR BACHELOR QUARTERS

- ◆ The Army Housing Division manages 110 Senior Bachelor Quarters for E6 and above.
- ◆ These units are conveniently located on post and are 2-bedroom apartment style homes with a carport.
- ◆ Senior Single Soldiers may apply for housing with Picerne Military Housing.
