

WASTE MANAGEMENT

USED MILITARY TIRES: Turn in to you Unit's motor pool.

USED MOTOR OIL: Each unit/activity maintenance area has red used oil containers that should be used for any used oil found in the unit/activity areas.

USED BATTERIES:

USED MILITARY LEAD-ACID BATTERIES: Turn in to the JRTC & Fort Polk Recycling Center (building 3620/3622).

OTHER BATTERIES (radio, cell phones, cracked or leaking lead acid batteries, UPS, etc.): Turn in at the HAZMART for recycling.

MILITARY BATTERIES: Turn in at the Consolidate Solid Waste Point (8300 block).

PROPANE CYLINDERS:

GRILL CYLINDERS (5 GALS): Refill for future use, exchange at AAFES for a full cylinder or return to vendor where purchased.

SMALL CYLINDERS (0.5 GALS): Turn in to the Consolidate Solid Waste Point (8300 block) for potential reuse.

PAINT AND SOLVENTS: Turn in to HAZMART for proper management. No household or off-post hazardous material or waste will be accepted at this facility.

BULK ITEMS:

PERSONAL ITEMS (ex. grills, furniture, old bicycles and TVs): Place next to dumpsters for pick up.

PROPERTY BOOK ITEMS: Turn in to your supply for proper disposal.

SCRAP METAL: All identifiable items such as furniture and obsolete non-functional equipment will first have to be processed through the installation property book and classified as scrap. Classification will stamp the 1348 form with a stamp as "Scrap Metal cleared for turn in to the QRP". There will be no exceptions to this policy. The 1348 form will have to be presented prior to entry into the QRP Yard. If it is easily identifiable scrap, the unit will need to have a 1348-1 form properly filled out. The unit and point of contact needs to be clearly printed. It also needs to state that it is "Scrap Metal".

SCRAP WOOD: Deposit scrap wood into roll off dumpsters provided by the solid waste contractor at the old Chaffee Road Landfill (13000 block) located between North and South Fort. One roll off dumpster will be located near the entrance of the landfill. This roll off will be solely designated for scrap wood pallets, no other wood waste will be deposited in that roll off dumpster. Absolutely no vegetative debris (i.e. tree limbs and pine needles) allowed in the scrap wood roll offs.

DRY SWEEP: See your unit Environment Compliance Service Technician for guidance.

YARD WASTE (pine straw, tree limbs, grass clippings, leaves, etc.): NO POV will be allowed to enter the Chafee Road Landfill. The only authorized vehicles that can enter into this facility are GSA and military vehicles.

PINE STRAW will be raked, bagged and brought to the Chafee Road Landfill for recycling. Pine straw should be raked into piles using a yard rake. The pine straw piles must be free of debris (paper, plastic, wood, metal, cans, candy wrappers, etc.) Additionally, items such as pine cones and tree limbs should be removed. After the piles are free of debris, the pine straw is then collected into large plastic bags and transported to the Green Waste area at the old Chafee Road Landfill. Do not place bags along the curb and expect that they will be picked up. It is the unit's responsibility to provide transportation (no POV are authorized).

TREE LIMBS/SHRUB TRIMMINGS will be brought to the Chafee Road Landfill for recycling. Tree limbs/shrub trimmings must be free debris (paper, plastic, wood, metal, cans, candy wrappers, etc.). No dimensional lumber or plywood will be accepted. Tree limbs should be cut into pieces small enough to be manageable by hand. If possible collect into large plastic bags or easily emptied into the storage area. The bags/containers will be removed from the consolidated staging area.
