**NOTICE OF DELAY  
TO THE  
U.S. ARMY MEDICAL ACTIVITY (MEDDAC) REDUCTION IN FORCE**

1. The purpose of this bulletin is to notify all MEDDAC/DENTAC/VETCOM employees of a **delay** in the reduction in force, which was announced in Civilian Personnel Bulletin (CPB) No. 15-01.
2. As stated in paragraph 2 of CPB 15-01, the projected dates were subject to change because RIF notices could not be issued until receipt of HQDA clearance to proceed with the conversion and issuance of notice to proceed or award of unconditioned contract had been accomplished by the contracting officer. As of this date, neither one of these actions has occurred. We were advised by the Medical Command Contracting Office that it is difficult to determine how long the approval process will take, but it could take up to sixty (60) days.
3. We sincerely regret any additional stress you may suffer due to the uncertainty of the RIF effective date. We assure you that you will receive immediate notification when the effective date is known, and all RIF entitlements required by regulation and contained in CPB 15-01 will be afforded to you.
