## GENERAL - CARPORTS

## 1. CARPORT COVER –20 FT. LONG X 30 FT. WIDE

A. SHEET METAL SHALL BE 26 GAGE – ATTACHED TO STEEL SUPERSTRUCTURE WITH SELF TAPPING SHEET METAL ROOFING SCREWS WITH APPROPRIATE RUBBER GROMMETS TO PREVENT LEAKAGE. SCREWS SHALL HAVE UMBRELLA LIKE FLANGE TO ENSURE PROPER RAIN WATER RUN-OFF.

B. COLOR – WHITE (Exterior)

## SUPPORT LEGS AND BUILDING SUPER STRUCTURE

A. 8 FT. LONG, 16 GAGE GALVANIZED PIPE OR TUBING ( ROUND OR SQUARE)MINIMUM 2 3/8” OUTSIDE DIAMETER.

B. KNEE BRACED AT TOP AS PER INDUSTRY STANDARD

C. BOTTOM RAILS AND ROOF SUPPORT SUPERSTRUCTURE SAME MATERIALAND SIZE AS SUPPORT LEGS

2. CARPORTS SHALL BE OPEN ON BOTH ENDS AND ON EACH SIDE. BUILDINGS SHALL INCLUDE MATCHING TRIM TO COVER EXPOSED SHEET METAL EDGES IN ACCORDANCE WITH INDUSTRY STANDARDS.

3. CARPORTS SHALL BE ANCHORED IN ACCORDANCE WITH INDUSTRY STANDARDS.

All carports to be delivered, setup and anchored with appropriate anchoring devices as per industry standards. Set-up locations will be identified and prepared by Government Point of Contact.

## PURCHASE AND SET-UP OF METAL CARPORT BUILDINGS

## FORT POLK, LOUISIANA

## Section 1

## Work Statement

## 1. General

1.1 Scope of Work - The contractor shall provide all labor, materials, maintenance and equipment incidental to the purchase, deliver and set-up of metal carport prefabricated buildings, as required in the bid schedule and this statement of work.

1.2. Background Information - Fort Polk is located in west central Louisiana outside the city of Leesville, approximately 45 miles west of Alexandria and 20 miles north of DeRidder.

1.3 Location - The Contractor shall deliver equipment as directed in each Delivery Order to sites onboard Fort Polk military reservation to include North and South Fort cantonment areas and Peason Ridge Training Area.

1.4 Coordination - The Contractor shall coordinate all delivery time(s), date(s) and location(s) with the Government Point-of-Contact identified in this contract and/or the Contracting Officer's Representative. The POC will normally be an authorized representative of the requesting organization as stated in the Delivery Order.

1.5 Regulations - Government rules, regulations, directives, and requirements that are in effect at the contract start date and those issued during the contract term relating to law and order, administration and security shall be applicable to Contractor personnel and their representatives.

1.6 Gate Closures - The Government will not compensate the Contractor for delays in entering or departing the installation, due to gate closures or vehicle searches.

## 2.0 Safety

2.1 OSHA Compliance - The Contractor shall comply with the occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA). Contractor personnel shall wear safety items required by OSHA during the performance of tasks requiring safety clothing or equipment.

2.1.1 SAFETY: The Contractor shall safeguard and maintain all Government property as well as comply with any safety directives and procedures required to insure for the safety and well being of personnel employed under this contract.

2.1.2 Accident Reporting - The Contractor shall maintain an accurate record of all accidents occurring in the performance of this contract, resulting in personal injury, occupational illness or Government property damage. The Contractor shall verbally report each incident to the Contracting Officer Representative and the JRTC and Fort Polk Safety Office within four (4) hours of the incident. The Contractor shall cooperate with the Safety Office and provide written documentation as requested and required by AR 385-40, Safety Accident Reporting and Records. Serious injury or death incidents will be reported immediately.

## 3. Contractor Personnel

3.1 Employment of Aliens: The Contractor shall not employ any alien who does not possess a valid U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service Alien Registration Card.

3.1.1 Conflict of Interest - The Contractor shall not employ any off-duty person who is an employee of the United States Government or the Department of Defense, either military or civilian, if such employment would create a conflict of interest or be contrary to the policies contained in DOD 5500-7R, Joint Ethics Regulation dated 30 August 1993. The Contractor shall not employ any person who is an employee of the Department of Defense, unless such person receives prior approval in accordance with DOD 5500-7R, Joint Ethics Regulation.

3.2 Contractor Representative – The Contractor shall make available a responsible individual to be the Point of Contact (POC) with the Government. The Contractor's Representative shall be the Point of Contact with the Government and have the authority to act or make decisions for the Contractor on all matters pertaining to this contract.

3.2.1 Alternate – The Contractor shall designate an alternate who shall be authorized to act on behalf of the Contractor in the absence of the Contractors designated representative or when the Contractor's designated representative is not available.

3.3 Contractor Personnel Identification – Ten days after award of this contract or before the contract start (whichever is earlier), the Contractor shall submit in writing the full name, date of birth, social security number, address and telephone number of all personnel scheduled to perform on work under this contract on Fort Polk, Louisiana.

3.4 Vehicle Operation - Contractor personnel operating a vehicle onboard the installation shall comply with Fort Polk Regulation 190-5, Motor Vehicle Traffic supervision.

#### 4. Specific Tasks

4.1 Delivery - The Contractor shall deliver and set-up ordered items between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:30 PM of normal work days. (See Clause 52.000-4004 entitled, "Hours of Operation" incorporated herein)(See Clause 52.216-19 entitled, "Order Limitations" incorporated herein).

4.2 The Contractor shall take extreme care to prevent spillage of solvents, cleaners, oils, grease, fuels and other contaminants during maintenance procedures. In the event of a spillage, the Contractor shall thoroughly clean the area affected by the spill. If a spillage of over 3 gallons occurs, the Contracting Officer shall be promptly notified.

4.3 Contract Discrepancy Notification – The Contracting Officer will provide notification to the Contractor of any contract discrepancy noted during Government QA inspections. The Contractor shall explain in writing, why the performance was unsatisfactory; how performance shall be returned to satisfactory levels; and how recurrence of the problem shall be prevented in the future.

#### 2. Applicable Documents

Publications – The Government will provide access to any mandatory publications necessary to perform the required tasks and specifications of this contract.

2.2 Supplements, amendments and/or revisions to mandatory documents may be issued during the term of this contract and shall be in full force and effective upon written approval of the Contracting Officer. The Contractor shall adhere to the requirements of these mandatory supplements, amendments and/or revisions during the life of the contract.

2.3 Upon completion of this contract, the Contractor shall return to the Government all publications provided to the Contractor by the Government.
