

Are You a Military Spouse?

The Fort Polk Installation Tax Center wants to remind military spouses who are working while here with the Soldier, and who meet the conditions for the Military Spouses Residency Relief Act, that it is time to file your new Louisiana Department of Revenue Form L-4E with your employer. This form is due the first of each year with your employer or immediately upon being hired at a new job with a Louisiana employer.

If you filed one last year and were exempt from withholding from Louisiana, it is time to do it again. This form is available on our website under [Useful Links](#). You can also find this form using a search engine, by typing in Louisiana Department of Revenue. Open the option for Louisiana Tax Forms. In that search block type "Form L-4E". Open the form and ensure that the top left of the document reflects "R-1307 (1/10)" and the heading reflects "State of Louisiana Exemption from Withholding Louisiana Income Tax".

One completed form has to be provided to your employer and a copy should be maintained in your tax records for the state of Louisiana. The Fort Polk Installation Tax Center will have these forms available. The Tax Center is located at 1881 23rd Street (Building 2502) on the corner with Alabama Avenue. The office opens on 17 January 2012. The telephone number to make an appointment for FREE tax preparation is (337) 531-1040. The office hours are from 0900 – 1600 daily and 0900 – 1200 on Saturdays.
